

Quarantine and isolation

No more isolation/quarantine certificates will be issued! Proof of the positive test is also sufficient for the employer.

Isolation for **infected people**

For the general population

7 days with test to release

The following is valid without testing: Release from isolation or quarantine after 10 days

In general, isolation or quarantine can only be ended when the affected persons are symptom-free.

The following contact people **do not have to quarantine:**

Those who have received a booster vaccination, "recently" double vaccinated*, vaccinated recovered people and recovered people*. One is considered to be recovered after a period of 28 days following a positive PCR test. Please refer in this case to the specific provisions.

* When the illness/vaccination occurred less than 3 months ago.
